
Global Hunger Threat

- 811 million people worldwide go to bed hungry each night in 2021
- According to Global Hunger Index **47 countries** have high levels of hunger in 2021. The war in Ukraine is estimated to bring this number to more than 60 countries in 2022.
- **3.1 million children die** from undernutrition each year
- Hunger riots, wars and refugee migration in Africa and Asia are inevitable.



Food and general price (hyper)inflation

The FAO Food Price Index rises to a new all-time high in February.



Wheat price added 50% after Russia invasion



Further price increase is looming as long-term blockade of Ukrainian ports and food export is not yet priced by the markets.

Ukrainian ports

UA exported 5-6 MMT/month of grains through sea ports and 500-700 KMT/month of sunoil before the war. Seaborn export accounts for 95% of Ukrainian food export.

Now:

- Sea ports are blocked (Danube ports are insufficient)
- Commercial vessels are under attack of Russia
- Sea mines are deployed


UA sea ports are blocked by Russian Navy



Alternative export routs

- UA redirected export flows to western border with EU countries via railway and trucks to EU Baltic and Black Sea ports.
- Capacity only 0.6-1 MMT/month
- Current stocks of grains for export 20 MMT (18-24 months w/o sea ports!!!)
- New crop will have no available storage
- Years and billions of dollars will be wasted w/o Black sea ports
- No export = No money = No further crops

UA railway redirect cargo to western border with EU



Summary

- World will face starvation, hunger riots, refugee migration without UA food supply. There is no sufficient alternative to cover the gap.
- Inflation will escalate further due to high food prices.
- UA 2022 and further crops are under risk of failure.
- Unblocking of UA sea ports key for World food security.

Actions to be taken urgently:

- International pressure on russia, escalation of the problem via major food buyers (China, Turkey, Egypt, Saudi Arabia...)
- Embargo and blockade of russian sea exports
- Provision of powerful anti-ship weapons to Ukraine
- Support by US Navy and Royal Navy (UK) to clear Black sea from mines (minesweepers)

Spring planting campaign 2022

- UA is going to plant no more than 14 mln ha (70%) of spring crops area in 2022.
- Biggest loss in North-East, East and South.
- Farmers plan to seed less corn, more soybean and sunflower.

Fertilizers – 80%

Seeds - 75%

Pesticides – 60%

Diesel fuel – 40%

Finance – 40%

Planting campaign under risk of failure due to lack of finance and fuel
