5 Section 47107 of title 49, United States Code, is6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 "(t) ELIGIBILITY FOR AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT 8 GRANTS OF AIRPORTS THAT ENTER INTO CERTAIN 9 LEASES WITH COMPONENTS OF THE ARMED FORCES.— 10 The Secretary of Transportation may not disapprove a project grant application under this subchapter for an air-11 port development project at an airport solely because the 12 13 airport enters into or renews a lease for the use, at a nomi-14 nal rate, of airport property by a regular or reserve component of the Armed Forces, including the National Guard, 15 16 without regard to whether that component operates aircraft at the airport.". 17
